The Web Based Teaching Tool (WBTT) is an early screening and intervention program for primary teachers funded by the Ontario Ministry of Education. This online program helps teachers determine which students in their classroom need additional support by determining which areas they are struggling with, and how their areas of need can be addressed within the classroom.
